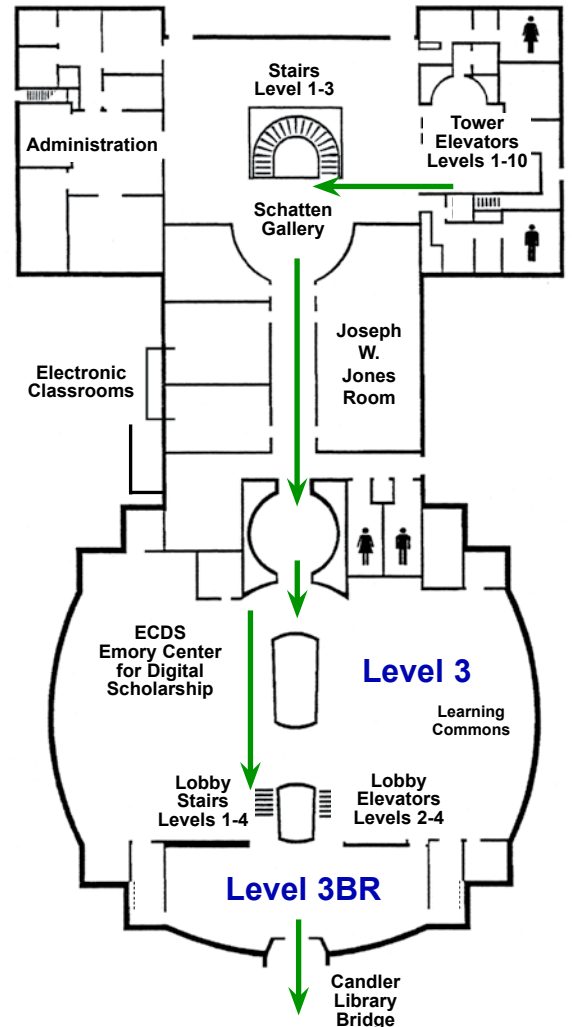

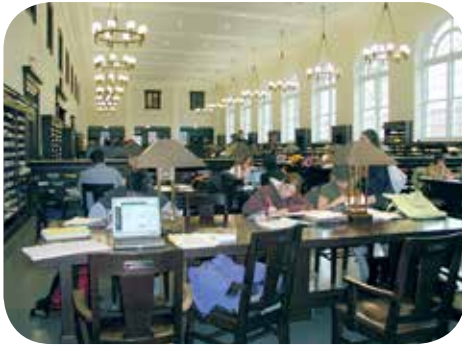

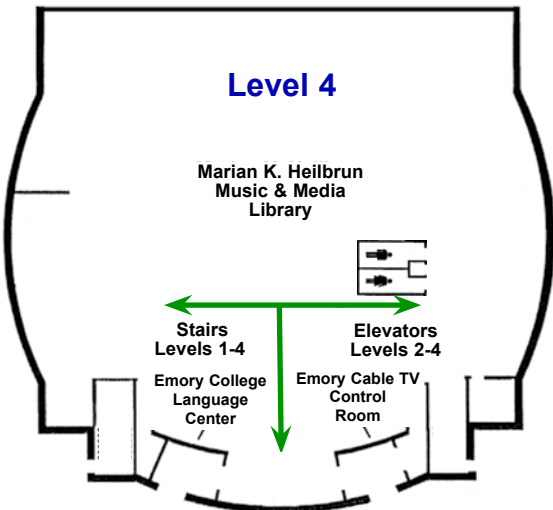
Take the Lobby steps up to Level 3BR and Candler Library

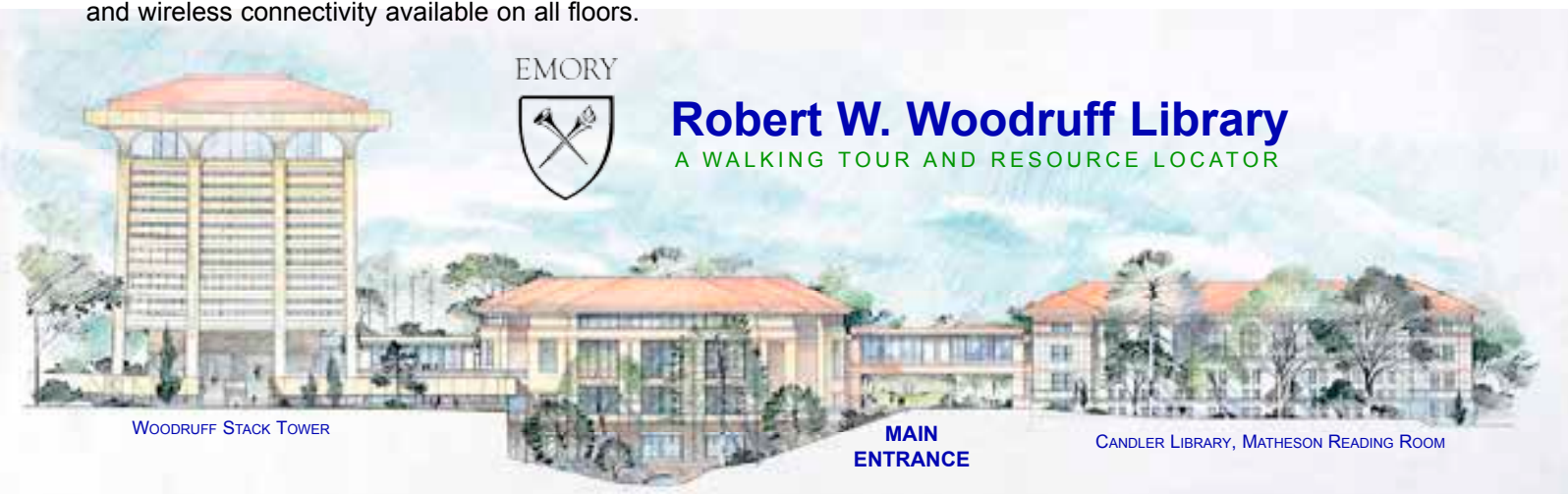

Woodruff Library offers the full array of services and resources found in a major academic research library of the twenty-first century. Integrated services provided by library and information technology staffs, print and electronic resources, distinctive special and archival collections, technology centers, and comfortable study spaces combine to create an innovative, inviting environment for scholarly inquiry, research, and teaching.

The Goizueta Business Library; Marian K. Heilbrun Music and Media Library; Stuart A. Rose Manuscript, Archives, and Rare Book Library; and the Emory Center for Digital Scholarship are also housed in the complex. As many as 5,000 people use the library on site each day with twenty-four hour access, Learning Commons workstations on Levels 1-3, and wireless connectivity available on all floors.



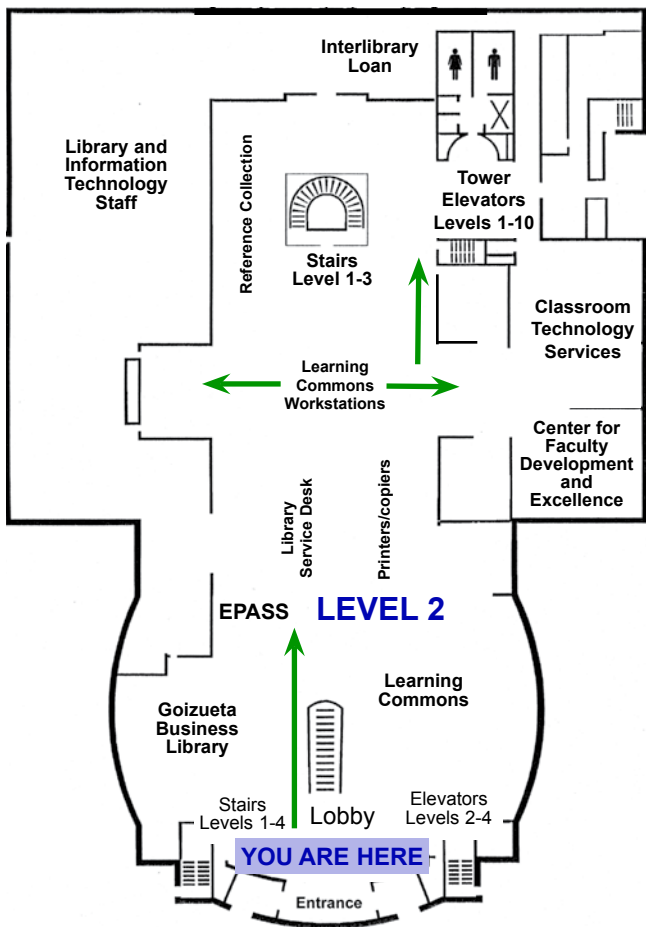

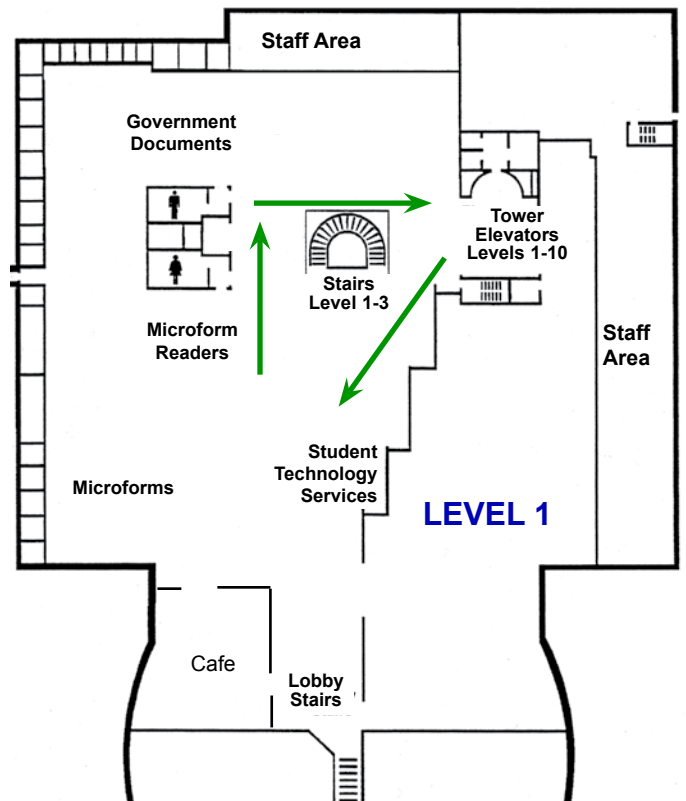

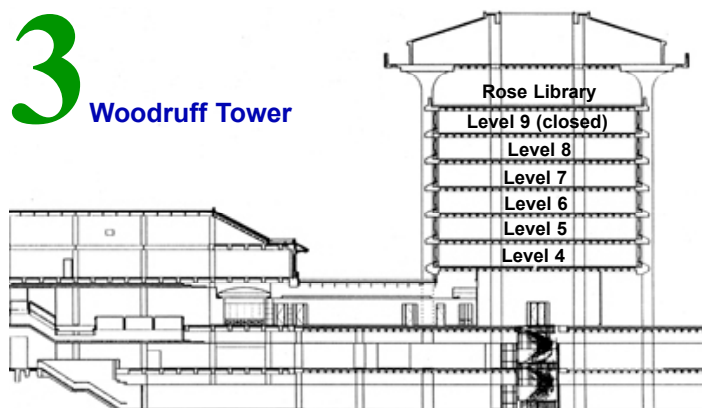
