What's new: Emory Center for Digital Scholarship



We are excited to announce the formation of the Emory Center for Digital Scholarship (ECDS). The ECDS brings together four units already housed in the Robert W. Woodruff Library: the [Digital Scholarship Commons](#) (DiSC), the [Electronic Data Center](#), the [Lewis H. Beck Center for Electronic Collections](#) and the [Emory Center for Interactive Teaching](#) (ECIT). These units have each collaborated with Emory scholars to incorporate technology into their teaching and research. The formation of the ECDS will bring that talent and expertise together, break down barriers and simplify how we establish partnerships across the university.

Opening soon: The new Oxford College Library and Academic Commons

The beautifully remodeled and expanded library at Oxford College - named the [Oxford College Library and Academic Commons](#) - re-opens on June 10, with a grand opening ceremony scheduled for Saturday, Aug. 24 at 3:30 pm. The makeover included a complete renovation of the existing 20,000-square-foot library and a 10,000-square-foot addition to the front of the building; more group and individual study spaces, and upgraded wiring and wireless access throughout the building. The building's design now resembles the historic buildings adjacent to it. This is the Oxford library's first major remodeling since the current building opened in 1970.
