



## Emory Libraries welcome Yolanda Cooper as new University Librarian

Emory University has appointed Yolanda Cooper as University Librarian, a recently redefined position in the Library and Information Technology Services organization.

Cooper will join Emory from the University of Miami, where she most recently served as acting dean and university librarian. She brings 25 years of administrative experience in university libraries across five library systems.

She will begin her new role leading the [Emory Libraries](#) on Jan. 15, overseeing areas of services, content, scholarly communications, external affairs and library administration, as well as the [Manuscript Archives, and Rare Book Library](#) (MARBL). Her responsibilities will include outlining ways in which library services, digital scholarship and informational technology can better support Emory's mission and vision.

Cooper will report to Rich Mendola, enterprise CIO and senior vice provost of library services and digital scholarship. Mendola implemented an organizational restructuring this year that has combined Emory's library and information technology organizations, which reflects the increasingly important relationship between digital technologies and research libraries.

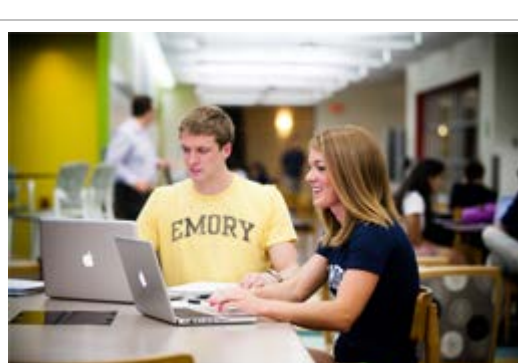
The libraries at Emory University welcome Yolanda Cooper and look forward to working with her.
